Inter-generational buddying programme - young people at risk are trained to teach older generation to use computers through games, art, music

Needs: co-ordinator and/or youth worker seconded from partner organisation. Software.

REFUGEE LEARNING

Create volunteer network among refugee families in ICT learning to link them as "buddies" to similar groups nationally and promote integration locally

Needs: Co-ordinator, tutors, language skills.

NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

Local neighbourhood watch volunteers have email, web and web cams to support their work

Needs: co-ordinator, volunteers, ICT room/support, link to police

CREDIT UNION

A credit union is set up to run from the centre, using technology for records and communication.

Needs: partner, advice/help for start up and continuing support. ICT room

DIY LOCAL CHANGE

Community groups coordinate volunteers to improve the area by tackling litter, abandoned cars and neglected gardens.

Needs: Coordinator, volunteers, ICT room/support

FIND A VOICE

Young people involve older generation in telling stories of their area, and pass on ICT skills.

Needs: co-ordinator and/or youth worker seconded from partner organisation. Equipment

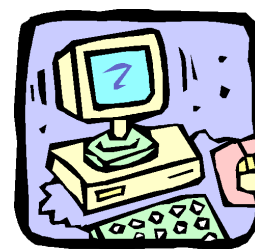


YOUTH MENTORING

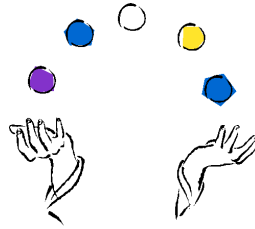


ICT SUPPORT CHAMPIONS
